MURAL BY NEW ORLEANS ARTIST PLANNED FOR 270 PEACHTREE

Downtown is getting a bit of the Big Easy.

A mural by New Orleans artist Alexander Stolin is among the upgrades pending for the lobby at 270 Peachtree.

According to building owner Richard Bowers & Co., 270 will also get new lighting, new furniture and Italian marble floors. The renovations, costing more than \$1 million, are expected to be completed in February.

Cooper Carry Inc. is overseeing the project. Cooper Associate Director Steve Berberich said the improvements will "dramatically upgrade the lobby of 270 Peachtree with more light, and there will be greater visibility from Peachtree Street as well."

The building's tenants include Southern Co., KPMG and a Corner Bakery restaurant.
